TREASURER'S REPORT

We have just completed our second successful athletic season, successful not only in our athletic achievements but also in respect of our financial position.

Although not flush with liquid funds our situation is much better than at the same time last year. Again we must thank our President, John Wheeler, for his financial assistance in the early part of the season when our liquid funds were almost nil. I am pleased to report that the loan account (monies loaned by Mr. J. Wheeler) has been repaid in full and the club is clear of all liabilities at the time of this report.

Following this report is a Statement of affairs and Summary of financial position set out in simple terms, rather than a Balance Sheet format which is sometimes difficult for most to ascertain quickly our true situation.

We currently have a bank balance of \$93.68 compared with \$3.70 last season and it is pleasing to see a reduction in the stock of singlets to the extent of \$84 (sale value) from last season. When looking at the current unsold stock figure \$308.50 as against last season \$324.00, please bear in mind that the club badges added to our stock holding this season \$68.50 tends to detract from the improvement in this area.

It should be mentioned that even with additional expenses this season, trophies and new equipment for example, our financial position has improved. BUT our income analysis (A) lacks one very important item "FUND RAISING ACTIVITIES", so come on Club Members -- this should be the area for improvement next season.

Thanks John and Lex, for your assistance again this season and to all our athletes I wish them every success for the coming season 1980/81.

RECORDER'S REPORT

The handicap points score system which operated during the 1979/80 season was very successful in achieving greater interest in our weekly meetings.
