PRESIDENT/SECRETARY'S REPORT

Whilst our membership was down on past years the standard of competitiveness has been of a high quality, due I believe to an improved programme including hurdles and 3 and 5 K distance events.

Tracey Wheeler and Ralph Downer enjoyed good successes at the NSW Track & Field, being this Club's first athletes to enter this State Championship. State Age athletes performed well in spite of injuries, with most achieving their best performances. There were good attendances at other venues including the winter distance events, with Bob Sewell competing every weekend and John Doolan on not so regular basis.

Deborah Mulhall, whilst not a high performance athlete, showed us how to become Club Female Champion while competing in all but 5K events. Both Deborah and overall Champion, Phillip Fenech, deserve high praise for their efforts, and to the runners up also, who all performed well.

Personal bests and club records were the order of the day on most Saturdays. We well remember 5th December when 24 best performances were recorded in temperature of 41°; on 31st October when 18 bests resulted during a raining and cold afternoon; Blacktown City Games when the rain never eased throughout the entire meet; the Orange Blossom Festival when windy conditions blew dust continually and officials had to sit on the High Jump bags to secure them from blowing away which did occur many times; but our athletes continued competing and did so well.

One thing is certain, unless we can procure the services of coaches this could very well spell the downfall of our Club. A call for coaches was made through the "Advertiser" with only one enquiry from an 18-year old at Mt. Druitt, but due to transport problems he was not able to assist. We have good facilities and equipment but lack coaching personnel.

Parramatta "Advertiser" gave us improved coverage but as Bob mentions in his report, articles in detail were not used. Perhaps we can hope that next year we may be successful as each year we gain a better deal.

Membership of ex Little A's is still low in number but we are endeavouring to encourage U/11s and U/12s to participate in events not in the Little A's programme to hold their interest. We are battling against youngsters who have experienced too much athletics and most have been driven hard by enthusiastic parents by the time they are U/12 and they are reluctant to continue with athletics, seeking instead other activities.

In conclusion, I congratulate all athletes, committee members, club officials and coaches in the harmonious way they have assisted in the conduct of the Girraween A.A.C. Working as a team certainly shows results in our athletes' performances and this year has been no exception.

RECORDING

Although the point score system has remained basically the same for 1981-82 season, the adjusted range of performance in the table for certain events and the staggered starting heights for High Jump have made for more equitable overall results.

The handicap base was selected at 30 points this season which meant that any athlete performing to his or her handicap would have achieved a total of 1080 points for the season. In fact 20 athletes scored in excess of this figure indicating a consistent improvement.

Only one minor adjustment appears necessary to the point score table to achieve a comparable spread of points in all events and this will be done before next season. Finally, my thanks go to all who assisted in the calculation and reporting of results. The job is not difficult but is time consuming and more assistance would I am sure be most welcome by whoever accepts the position next season.
