## PRESIDENT/SECRETARY'S REPORT

Without doubt this has been the Club's best ever season. Club membership of 56 athletes, including many more seniors than before, saw participation in Blair Zone Inter-Club, Gala Days, Cross Country, Nepean Triathlon, as well as Girraween Club competition.

Saturday afternoon competition was conducted regardless of the prevailing weather conditions, and this I believe contributed immensely to our athletes' outstanding performances and personal achievements both at home and away. 40 medals at Zone Championships, 57 major placings in three Gala Days in January, 4 medals at State Age Championships, and top performances at other meetings. May I extend my personal thanks to all members for their fine efforts in conducting the Club's many functions, thus making my position as President one of satisfaction.

Our fifth athletic season has once again proved to be a very successful one from the point of view of finance. On the next page is the Financial Statement for 1982/83.

We commenced the year with \$256.07 in the Holroyd Building Society, which later became the Pacific Savings Building Society Ltd., and \$22.00 in our Special Representative Fund.

With regard to our Singlet Stock, we had 14 in hand, bought 45 from Team Tops and sold 28 during the season. This left us with 31 in stock valued at \$248.00 and includes 3 T-shirts.

Our Fund Raising efforts were quite outstanding this year and included Market Research \$310.00, Runathon \$432.76, and Hamburger Stall \$170.46, as well as the Nestles' sponsorship of our future steeplechase equipment. Our sincere thanks go to this company for their generous support.

At the end of the season \$100 was transferred to the Special Representative Fund and this together with interest now totals \$123.95.

I would like to thank all members and officials for their enthusiastic support of our fund raising ventures during the year and would like to wish all members success next season.

## RECORDING OFFICER'S REPORT

The point score system was unchanged this year. However, having only five competition rounds instead of six, any athlete performing on handicap all season, could achieve 900 points compared with 1080 last season. In fact 22 achieved more than 900, 18 more than 1000, 13 more than 1100 and 4 more than 1200. In one particular round one of our athletes managed to score the maximum possible 300 points -- the first time this has been done since the points score was introduced. Many of those who scored 900 points achieved more than was expected as they either had not competed in all five rounds or did not compete in six events per round.

My thanks go to all those people who assisted in the point score calculations and, as I shall be having a rest from athletics this coming season, my best wishes to the officials and Club for the 1983 season.
