COMMITTEE REPORTSPRESIDENT

This, our ninth year, has probably been the quietest and least competitive. Whilst holding membership numbers, there was not the usual emphasis on training, coaching and Inter-club interest, and this coupled with lack of visiting clubs contributed to subdued Club activities. Improvement is in sight with interest shown by neighbouring clubs Grey-stanes and Liberty Plains in competing with us on Saturdays.

Two meetings with these clubs have been promising and to date we have agreed to combine our membership promotion, and agreed to reject the Association's request to amalgamate.

Congratulations to Paul Sewell U/14, recently awarded 10-years service with Girraween Little A's - a tremendous achievement and he could make this a double in a few years with this Club.

Committee activities were extended this season to assisting the Little A's in the upgrading and extension of the Long/ Triple Jump facilities, and as Project Supervisor I was pleased with the eagerness and willingness of parents and Senior Club members devoting their time during the winter months to construct what we consider the best in this State. Thanks to the Department of Sport & Recreation, Holroyd Council and the Little Athletic Centre for financing this project.

Unfortunately Tony Braithwaite had to relinquish the position of Secretary early in the season, but we look forward to his return when his work situation settles down.

As Club President it is a pleasure when the Committee performs well and this season has been exceptional. The Club's internal organisation, necessary for the conduct of Saturday meetings, was moulded to perfection, and this included many long hours preparation for the Multi-Event Carnival. I thank all those families who participated, obviously with the Club members' interest in mind.

We started the season without a Canteen Manager and members were relieved when Elizabeth and Jim McIlwaine came to the rescue. Sales were quiet but like our past canteen personnel they made a hit with Club members and produced a reasonable profit to assist the Club's commitments.

TREASURER/REGISTRAR
