COMMITTEE REPORTS

PRESIDENT

When Viv Manwaring and I became secretary and president nine years ago, the club was in a slump. For two years membership continued to drop, reaching an all-time low of 20. We made a concerted effort to revitalise the club and gradually built membership up to the high 50's, reaching 61 in the 1993/94 season.

Since then, however, membership has begun to drop again with 37 in 1994/95 and 33 in 1995/96. Female membership has slumped dramatically.

Why is it? With the Atlanta Olympics just finished and four years to the Sydney Games, I would expect a surge in the popularity of athletics. But other clubs are also experiencing a drop in membership and the 75 year old St George Club is struggling to survive according to an article in "Athletically".

At a recent club conference held by Athletics NSW (ANSW), there was discussion on "the perception of elitism in athletics which was turning potential members away". I believe this could be the key to the falling popularity of athletics. ANSW runs State championships and the interdistrict competition, but does nothing for the fun athlete. Perhaps our publicity should emphasise the fun aspect more in future.

This club started as the Girraween - Greystanes Amateur Athletic Club in 1978 to provide competition close to home for ex-little athletes from the Girraween and Greystanes Centres which, at that time, finished at U12's. After two years, the Greystanes group was guided to the now defunct Liberty Plains Club and we changed our name and uniform.

When little athletics introduced U13's, then U14's and finally U15's, our supply of athletes was reduced and now we are lucky if we ever sign up any ex-U15 athlete from the Girraween Centre. Most of them retire when they leave little athletics. On the other hand, we are now attracting more veteran men.

We do not have any registered officials and consequently all timekeeping, starting and recording has to be done by athletes. Last season this became a problem because of the low membership, and some of the timekeeping was not of the desired standard. By the time the distance race came around at the end of the program, there was hardly anyone left at the ground to do timekeeping and lap scoring.

On the high performance front, Adrian Grogan, Jessica Fisher, Peter Balinski, Brent Balinski, Linda Balinski, Lonnie Balinski, and Phillip Bowden all won State medals. After the season ended, Adrian was selected to represent Australia in the Paralympics at Atlanta in the 400m, 800m, and 4x100m relay.

Last season, our involvement in the Blair Zone interclub competition was almost nil: Stephen Halverson and I attended on one occasion. Two members competed in the Sydney Interdistrict competition, and one competed in the NSW Race Walking Club program.

Fund raising efforts were successful, providing much needed funds. Most of this money goes to ground fees and water rates, but we must do more as the Little Athletics Centre plans to replace the high jump bags and we must help with the cost as we use the same bags.

One of our winter season runners, Bruce Harrison, thinks we could increase our funds and Saturday attendance by attracting more visitors and he is distributing our program to all runners he comes in contact with. I will be sending our program to the Smithfield, Westfields and restarted Parramatta Clubs as well as to schools in our area. I have also placed programs in five McDonalds restaurants. If all athletes present tonight could distribute copies of our program, it could help build our membership.

This winter, we have a membership of 16 athletes which is a good start to the season. However, we need to have a good attendance on Saturday 7 September if we are to attract new members. I invite everyone here tonight to attend our summer season opening day on 7 September, with registrations being accepted from 1pm.

SECRETARY

As I mentioned in my report last year, Clubs voted in favour of Athletics NSW becoming a company with limited liability. This happened on 16 January 1996 when Athletics NSW Limited began operations with a new structure. Our Club was accepted as a member with the name "Girraween Athletics Club". The word "Amateur" in our Club title was dropped by ANSW. The new Committee will need to consider the implications of this in terms of our logo and Constitution.

Blacktown City Council has applied to the State Government for funding assistance to develop a synthetic athletics track in Aquilina Reserve near Rooty Hill station. Council's intention is that the facility be developed before the year 2000 as an Olympic training venue, if funding support is forthcoming. I understand that it is Council's intention for such a facility to be available for general hire, such as with Homebush, and that any club(s) will not get "exclusive" use of it (I guess unless they are prepared to pay !). While such a facility in this area will present a great opportunity for athletes and promotion of the sport, we cannot ignore the possibility of its impact on the future viability of our Saturday afternoon competition.

Congratulations to Adrian Grogan for becoming our Club's first Olympian by representing Australia in the Atlanta Paralympics. Congratulations also to Bob Sewell for his coaching efforts with Adrian over the last (I think) three years to get him to that level of performance. Adrian is only 19 years old, so we all need to encourage and support him to Sydney 2000.

A number of initiatives are being taken by the Little Athletics Centre of which our members need to be aware:

- * An application for a sporting grant has been made to the Dept of Sport and Recreation, via the C V Kelly Park Trust and Holroyd City Council, to resurface two of the three long jump run-ups with similar synthetic material. Two of the surfaces have reached the end of their useful life after 10 years. The cost is over \$12,000 and the Little Athletics Centre is seeking a 50% subsidy. The success or otherwise of the application is anticipated around the end of December this year.
- * A "Mars" fund raising drive is happening now to 20 September to raise the \$3,000 needed to replace the high jump bags which are losing their resiliency after may years of use.
- * A uniform change, to brighten up the current uniform which is the same as ours, is being discussed for 1996/97 as an idea to celebrate their 25th year. There will need to be discussion about this between the two bodies before any final decision is made.

In relation to the long jump run-ups and high jump bags, we will need to consider what assistance we can give towards the cost of these facilities which are also used by us. For example, members could offer to be part of the "Mars" fund raising drive, and assist with labour when the existing long jump run-ups are removed prior to resurfacing. It needs to be remembered that 50% of our members in 1994/95 and 1995/96 (the only years checked) have had no link with the Little Athletics Centre, and for many of the others that link is tenuous.

REGISTRAR

Registrations for the 1995/96 season totalled 33 which is 3 down on the previous season.

Of these 33 registrations, 25 were male and 8 were female. The lack of female athletes continues to be a worry for us.

WINTER COMPETITION

The 1995 winter season of cross country and road races was one of the most successful for many years. The Club fielded close to 15 competitors most Saturday afternoons.

Performance-wise, the Club's juniors achieved very good results with Peter Balinski claiming four U12 State medals (1st, 2nd, and 2x3rd), Brent Balinski one U14 State medal (3rd), and Stephen Muir (4th) and Vikki Savage (5th) just missing State medals.

In the zone race series, the Club's runners won seven medals with Peter Balinski 1st U13, Brent Balinski 2nd U16, Vikki Savage 2nd U16, Linda Balinski 2nd Vets, Geoffrey Sheargold 3rd U10, Stephen Muir 3rd U16, and Bob Sewell 3rd over 50's.

We were also able to field three teams in the NSW Road Relay Championships.

The biggest improver was newcomer Richard Frost whose standard improved from 26+ minutes over 5km at the beginning of the season, to sub 22 minutes near the end of the season.

SUMMER COMPETITION

Last season we tried a modified point scoring system to eliminate two faults which were evident in previous seasons: the large number of athletes finishing in first place, and the other being that after dropping out of first place an athlete could never regain the lead.

The system is now based on scoring points in events as before (1, 11/2 or 2 points) but with the number of events that count each week being unlimited. At season's end, each athlete's worst 4 weekly scores are dropped from the 16 competition weeks. The tie-break system (as before) is then used to split ties.

Peter Balinski led all season and won comfortably with David Beattie, Graham Sheargold, Richard Frost, and Stephen Halverson conducting a close battle for the minor placings.

Jessica Fisher was an easy winner in the female competition with most of the athletes competing on an irregular basis.

"It looked like a lot of fun and a great way to keep fit, so after a while we figured we might as well join the club."


Brent has won three NSW medals in cross country, road walking and middle distance events while Peter has picked up four State medals, mostly in cross country runs.
