

## EULOGY TO NOEL JOHN WHEELER (always known as John)

#### Passed away 24 January 1997, aged 62 years.

John was born on 1st April 1934 at Epping, the eldest of three children. John's father served in the Air Force during World War II and consequently the family didn't see much of him then. As the eldest child, John's childhood was hard especially during the War years, and he always said he was the 'black sheep' of the family.

John finished school aged about 15 and went to a technical college to learn carpentry. He then progressed to qualifying as a Clerk of Works, mainly working on large buildings; eg Australian Paper Manufacturers complex at Botany, Smith Klein and French pharmaceutical factory at French's Forest, and the former Marcus Clark department store at Liverpool.

John then joined Marcus Clark as assistant property manager, travelling to all their stores in NSW and Adelaide until they closed down and sold out to Waltons. Subsequently, John worked for Rider Hunt and Partners as a quantity surveyor for nearly 30 years. Although not qualified, John was very capable of doing the task.

John worked on the Opera House shortly after construction started and stayed until the finish. He also worked on Westmead Hospital, Macquarie Shopping Centre, and State Bank HQ in Martin Place where he could have been killed in a fire. John and another man were trapped in the basement when they found the fire doors locked from the outside. The other man was taken to hospital to be checked over, but John insisted on coming home. The next day the company insisted he see a doctor. He was alright, but it took weeks to clear the smoke out of his lungs. There were about three other tall office blocks in the City that John worked on before he was retrenched in 1991 due to the building slump.

When John was young and living in Westmead, he joined the Scouts in which he was always interested. (For example, he assisted with organising the 50th year celebration for Westmead Scouts in about 1988). After leaving Scouts, John and two friends spent their spare time bushwalking all through the Blue Mountains, and he had a great knowledge of the terrain down to Moss Vale. John also played tennis and squash, and water-skied.

In 1961, John and I were married and John gave up his sports to build a home. When our daughters Jackie and Tracey joined Girraween Little Athletics in 1974, John's interest was so great that in the second year he became Secretary and held the positions of Secretary or President for many years. In 1978 John, with Jim Kendall from Greystanes Little Athletics, started a seniors club called Greystanes / Girraween Amateur Athletic Club to encourage children who were too old for little athletics (older than 12 at that time) to continue in the sport. John was involved with the seniors club until 1988.

Shortly before John's retrenchment from work in 1991, he undertook a course in leadlight and stained glass, and this along with gardening were his main interests in retirement. We also bought a campervan and took the opportunity to tour a lot of the country.

In 1995, we went on the long-talked of holiday to Europe and the UK. Shortly after our return, John had his gall bladder removed and within months, was diagnosed with a brain tumour. In 1996, John had two operations for brain tumours and one for bowel cancer. Unfortunately, those operations and radiotherapy did not help and John passed away on 24th January 1997.

In 1990 our daughters, Jackie and Tracey, moved to Perth to live. Tracey was married there in March 1997. Both girls are still very involved with women's soccer, another of their sports since their early teens. Jackie has been manager of a State junior team and coach of a youth team, as well as playing for WA herself until last year. Tracey is also a coach and works with the younger teams as a physiotherapist, and is goalkeeper for the Australian team with high hopes of going to the World Cup again in 1999 and the Olympics in 2000.

Jackie is a laboratory technician with Coca-Cola. Tracey is a self-employed physiotherapist, but this year is doing a university course in sports physiotherapy.

Our son, Michael, still lives in Sydney and is to be married in October. Michael played soccer and cricket but plays no sport now. Michael is an accountant with Rothmans at Granville.

I am still living in "the home that John built" at Wentworthville, but I plan to move to Perth within the next 12 months.

I came to know both John and Joan Wheeler some 20 years ago while slowly becoming more and more involved at Girraween Little Athletics.

A friend of mine suggested that Little Athletics would be great for the children. I said "Yes, but I'm not getting involved." He said "That's OK, but its great for the kids." On the very first night, John asked me to hold the tape measure at the long jump pit. Afterwards, he suggested that I might give the age manager a hand. Guess what? The following week that age manager didn't turn up and guess who became age manager? I knew I'd been conned.

That was not only my introduction to athletics, but also to a long association with the Wheeler family. This association has lead to an admiration of a family, a couple, a father and a man that I have learnt to admire, love and cherish as a friend.

John was never interested in recognition but rather in finding ways of getting the job done. The extension to the running track, the equipment shed, the discus cages, the long jump pits with tartan run-ups, were all innovations initiated by John Wheeler. John in 1979, and Joan in 1983, were made Life Members of Girraween Little Athletics. John, founder and President and Secretary and Life Member of Girraween Amateur Athletic Club, was always there to move the sprinkler every couple of hours right through the summer months.

One small faux pas that I will always remember was during the making of the discus areas. All the formwork was in place and John said he would organise the concrete. Yours truly, not to be outdone, suggested "No, I'll organise that." John asked very carefully if I would be able to calculate the amount. "of course I can!" Well, if ever you go to C V Kelly Park, right down at the northern end is what John suggested may one day be another shot put pad. Well, enough concrete came out of that truck to make six pads, and all the while me insisting that the concrete people had made a mistake.

Paul Keating recently knocked back the offer of the Order of Australia, suggesting that it should go to an unrecognised Australian. Well, if I had the power, I would bestow the Order of Australia on Noel John Wheeler.

#### COMMITTEE REPORTS

#### **PRESIDENT**

Although membership increased in 1996/97, the season was disappointing for a number of reasons:

- 1. Attendance at the Club on Saturday afternoons remained at a low 50% of membership.
- 2. As we do not have any registered officials, we have to rely on athletes for timekeeping, recording, starting and measuring. This has resulted in some athletes having to compete without warming up, as well as some inaccurate timekeeping.
- 3. Our first event is supposed to start at 2.00 pm, but the majority of athletes arrive at C V Kelly Park around this time which upsets the grading of heats and causes the program to start late.
- 4. Because of 3 above, the only people left when the distance event starts half an hour late are the competitors. Things became so bad at the end of the season that I acted as starter, then dropped the gun, caps and earmuffs and tried to catch the field. My thanks to David Beattie and Peter Hogan who stayed back to help on many occasions.
- 5. For the seventh year out of nine, I was forced to operate the canteen which is one of our major methods of raising funds. This means setting up, selling, buying, and taking stock home, which takes up too much of my time.
- 6. Only two athletes attended Blair Zone Interclub on a regular basis, and one attended Interdistrict at Homebush.
- 7. Female membership is still extremely low.
- 8. There is virtually no parental involvement in the running of the Club.
- 9. The Modified Program was not well supported with the last day of the summer season attracting only 8 athletes.

On a brighter note, the Club's financial situation is healthy, even though we did not introduce any new fund raising events. It is essential that we find a dedicated person to take on the fund raising position. If this does happen, I envisage the Club providing prizemoney to athletes in the future.

Last season was not a good one for me. Health problems and injuries combined to make life miserable, but the real problem is that 20 years of chronic insomnia have taken a toll on my mind and body.

This season, I will be unable to take on any position on the Committee. I do not have the time or the energy to continue.

In recent weeks, I have canvassed 22 high schools in the area bounded by Rooty Hill, Northmead, Winston Hills and Parramatta; bombarded Parramatta Advertiser, Blacktown Advocate, Blacktown City Guardian, Parramatta Sun and Warren's 'Sportz Shortz' (a free sports publication by Mark Warren, son of 'Rabs') with information about the Club and its activities; placed programs in the Blacktown Police Citizens Youth Club, Blacktown Tafe, 10 local McDonalds restaurants, and on notice boards at Blacktown and Wentworthville.

I feel sure that the new season will see a turn-around in the Club's fortunes.

As most of you know, the Club's founder John Wheeler passed away in January 1997. To ensure his memory lives on, we have renamed the Club Championship Shield the "John Wheeler Memorial Shield" which will be presented by Joan Wheeler tonight.

On 20 April 1997, Parramatta City Council renamed part of the reserve at the north end of Tucks Road, Toongabbie the "Sue Savage Park". Sue was the mother of one of our former athletes, Vikki Savage.

See you all on 6 September for our new season.

#### **SECRETARY**

As I mentioned in my report last year, our Club has been accepted as a member of Athletics NSW Limited (ANSW) with the name "Girraween Athletics Club", ie dropping of the word "Amateur". I don't know whether that was done by ANSW by intention or by accident, but the word "Amateur" is rather dated anyhow. You will be asked tonight to vote for or against formalising this name change.

Darryl Channells, a Board member of the Little Athletics Association of NSW, has the Board's support for him to seek ANSW agreement for registered ANSW athletes to compete at approved Little Athletics Centre competitions. The stated aim is to encourage athletes to stay in the sport who would otherwise have no other place to compete. The Executive of Girraween Little Athletics Centre (GLAC) has discussed this proposal, but will continue to encourage older athletes to compete with the seniors club on Saturday afternoons.

I understand that Darryl is also reforming the Blacktown City Club this coming season to compete at a number of Little Athletics Centres. I have also heard a whisper that Blacktown City Council's application to the State Government for funding assistance to develop a synthetic athletics track in Aquilina Reserve near Rooty Hill station has been successful. As I said last year, while such a facility in this area will present a great opportunity for athletes and promotion of the sport, we cannot ignore the possible impact of these developments on the future viability of our Saturday afternoon competition.

Congratulations to Phillip Bowden, I think the Club's oldest ever athlete at over 70 years of age, who just keeps on keeping on. Last season he collected gold medals in the NSW Veterans Track and Field Championships and Half Marathon, and also a bronze medal in his age group in the City to Surf. He successfully defended his City to Surf medal again last month.

GLAC has replaced the high jump bags, as the previous bags were at least 15 years old. Thanks to those who contributed to the fund raising effort by selling "Mars" confectionary. Particular thanks to Graham Sheargold and Stephen Halverson for working with GLAC to ensure the new bags met the needs of seniors. The final cost was \$6,316.55 with \$2,769 from the fund raising, \$1,500 donated by Boston Smash Repairs, and the remainder from GLAC funds. Boston Smash Repairs also extended the high jump trolley to accommodate the larger bags for free.

GLAC has been successful in its application for a sporting grant to resurface two of the three long jump run-ups with similar synthetic material. Two of the surfaces have reached the end of their useful life after 10 years. The cost is over \$12,000 and a 50% subsidy has been obtained. The details are being finalised with the contractor, and I hope the work can be carried out by the end of November.

I mentioned last year that GLAC was contemplating a uniform change to celebrate their 25th year. GLAC and our Club have the same uniform. Well, the decision from their AGM last May was to NOT change the uniform.

Holroyd City Council has been requested to remark the oval as a full 400m track, and will be replacing the fence over the next couple of weeks. Athletes and footballers are requested NOT to do stretches on the fence.

#### WINTER COMPETITION

In the Zone race series, the Club's runners won three medals with Leanne Bourke 1st Senior Women, Bruce Harrison 2nd Vet Men, and Geoffrey Sheargold 3rd U10 Men. In her first season with the Club, Leanne also finished 2nd in the women's section of the Parramatta Open 8 kms.

#### **CLUB RECORDS**

There were 9 records established in normal competition last season, which is up 4 on the previous year. In addition, 34 fun day events records were established.

#### SUMMER COMPETITION

Last season was our second year of using a modified point scoring system to eliminate two faults evident in previous seasons: the large number of athletes finishing in first place, and after dropping out of first place an athlete could never regain the lead.

The system is now based on scoring points in events as before (1, 11/2 or 2 points) but with the number of events that count each week being unlimited. At season's end, each athlete's worst 4 weekly scores are dropped from the 16 competition weeks. The tie-break system (as before) is then used to split ties.

Steve Halverson ended up comfortably winning the men's competition, and Jessica Fisher won the women's competition for the second year in a row after a very close tussle with newcomer Amanda McDonald. Congratulations to the award winners.
