Walkers' medals

GIRRAWEEN Athletics Club's top walkers Lisa Grant and Susan Ireland have won medals in the recent NSW Little Athletics Track and Field Championships at Homebush.

Competing in the under-14s 1500m walk, Grant won gold in 7.14.1 minutes while Ireland won bronze with a time of 7.29.9 minutes.

Grant is focussing on walking events, Ireland oncross country and road racing.

Athletics master ne move

CAN you run 5km in 23 minutes? Phil Bowden, the fastest 70 to 74-year-old in NSW from 200m to 10km, can.

The 72-year-old from Toongabbie recently produced the incredible feat of winning six State titles in his age group at the veterans championships.

It was his biggest haul yet, having won five last year and he only missed out on a clean sweep by coming third in the 100m.

What sets Bowden apart from his fellow veterans is that he does every running event, whereas other competitors usually concentrate on either sprints or distance races.

Asked why he does both, Bowden laughed: "I don't know - stupidity probably."

With all bar the 10,000m held over two days, his winning times are

worth noting: 200m (32sec dead), 400m (1.18.6min), 800 (3.03.7min) 1500m (6.10.3min), 5000m (23.08min) and 10,000m

(47.10min).

He ran the 100m in 15.2sec, just outside his personal best, and said: "I was hoping to get down under 14 seconds, but I think I've left my run a bit late.'

Bowden, who will be 73 next month,

run in Blacktown in 1985 - I thought I'd try myself out for the City to Surf.

"That was the Blacktown Advocate Fun Run and I ran it in a pair of old Dunlop volleys. I went all right so I invested in a good pair of shoes. "I've run in every City to Surf since

and this year will be my 15th. As for any earlier sporting interests, he had done only "a bit of waterskiing and, when I was younger, bike riding".

"But I've always been fairly active," added Bowden, who was a clerk of works with the State Public Works Department.

He runs year-round with Girraween Athletics Club and with the Parramatta Park Runners every Friday at 1pm: "That's an 8km run rain, hail or shine.'

But Bowden, who has never contested the national veterans titles because they are held around the same time as the State titles, is starting to lose interest.

"I've been running five days a week," he said. "My enthusiasm's not the same as it was earlier." And what do his family - wife Noelene, sons Garry and Alan, who are in their 40s, and grandchildren

think of his athletic pursuits? came to athletics late in life.

He explained: "I had in his fund." I m. bloodymad!"

The third World Cup for women, to be hosted by the United States over the next three weeks, will be followed just over 12 months later by the Olympics. It is a good time for a rejuvenated Murray to be hitting her stride.

Unwanted by former coach Tom Sermanni in the aftermath of a disappointing campaign in Sweden, she has fought back to become virtually indispensable to new coach Greg Brown.

Sale of singlets, competition fees, Christmas hamper, and 'cash for cans' also provide a small amount of income, but I feel we need to introduce a major fund raising activity each season to help with the cost of Park Trust ground fees, assistance to representatives to Australian championships, and equipment purchases.

SUMMER COMPETITION

Girraween Athletics Club enjoyed a highly successful 1998-99 season with 102 competitors taking part. Our President, Bob Sewell, gives much of his time to coach our athletes and his efforts have been reflected in the large number of records broken in both the traditional and modified competitions.

For the fourth consecutive year, a modified point scoring competition was used to determine the champions and placegetters. The system is based on an athlete scoring points by competing (1 point), equalling a personal best (1.5 points), or achieving a personal best (2 points). The four best events each week are counted for each competitor and the points accumulated. At the end of the season, the four lowest scoring weeks are subtracted from the total. This is a fair system which also allows for enthusiastic competition.

This year's competition was again decided on the last day. Graham Sheargold was this season's Club Champion, putting his points 'on the board' prior to the Christmas break. Graham consolidated his score of 101.5 with many fine efforts in the final weeks. Steve Halverson and Suresh Raju were placed equal second in the overall competition as well as in the men's competition with a score of 97. Steve Williams gained third place in the men's competition with 90 points.

The women's competition was won by **Samantha Marshall** with a score of 92. Samantha enjoyed her return to athletics, breaking a number of long-standing records. Chelsea Austin was 'pipped at the post', gaining second place on 91.5 points. Our champion walker, Lisa Grant, gained third place on 79 points.

A large number of visitors participated in our competition this year. Jemma Austin gained first place as Champion Female Visitor (77 points) and Graham Ryan took first place as Champion Male Visitor (50 points).
