SECRETARY'S REPORT 2017


Thank you once again to our President Wayne Thurlow, committee members and club members for their great contribution to Girraween Athletics Club for another year.

SUMMER COMPETITION REPORT

Girraween Athletics Club has once again enjoyed a highly successful Summer Competition. The 2016 / 2017 season enjoyed a good number of members competing at CV Kelly Park.

This season the weather was not kind this year with extreme rain and heat. This said, however, we managed only to cancel two days of competition. One from heat and one from wet.

Our point scoring system is based on an athlete scoring points by competing (1 point), equalling a personal best (1.5 points) or achieving a personal best (2 points). The four best events each week are counted for each competitor and the points accumulated over the season. At the end of the season, the four lowest scoring weeks are subtracted from each athlete's total. From this, the season's Club Champion is determined as well as the age category winners and the champion visitor. Athletes need to have completed at least 50% of the competition days held during the season to be eligible for awards. Competition days consist of both grading weeks and all other weeks excluding modified weeks. In the event that a competition week is cancelled all athletes will have this week allocated as attended, however the competition week must be cancelled prior to any track or field event being held.

There 2 weeks cancelled from the total of 20 which means a competitor is eligible for club champion and category winners if they competed in 8 or more events.

There are 1^{st,} 2nd and 3rd places are available within each summer competition category, catering for men and women. From these placing's, 1st, 2nd and 3rd summer champion awards are presented to the top three men and women. The highest award, Club Champion, is presented to the male or female who has scored the highest total of points for the summer season.





Summer Club Champion

The summer competition was a close, with only two points separating first and second. The winner this year showing continual improvement each year and well deserves this win. It is usually a very tight competition with only 4 or so points separating first and second and third. This year was no different, from first to third place was only 4 point, however from third to 4th was 25 points.

Nathan Moffit was the winner by two points at 120 points. When the worst four weeks were removed the gap stayed and the adjusted scores also remain unaffected.

Congratulations to Nathan Moffit who is our 2016 / 2017 season's Club Champion. This is Nathans fist summer club champion award after a second place in the competition last year

WINTER COMPETITION 2016

The Winter Competition had a total of 53 registered athletes who competed in the West Metropolitan, road and cross country running series and championships.

EXPLANATION OF THE WINTER CLUB COMPETITION CLUB POINT SCORE: 2016.

The point score was based on the participation in various West Metropolitan Zone Events. Competition for females and males are separate.

Athletes must have finished an event to score points in that event. To be eligible for a club award athletes must have completed at least half of the events on offer.

West Metropolitan Zone Races.

The Short (2km), Medium (4km), and the Long (8km) are open to all age groups.

Athletes were included in short, medium and Long distance category based on the distance they nominated at the commencement of the West Met season.

Where an athlete failed to notify the Winter Competition Manager of a nomination the athlete was allocated a category at the managers' discretion.

Points were awarded from the fastest to the slowest, i.e.; 1ST. finisher gains maximum points, 30, the 2nd. Place getter received 29 points and the 3rd place getter received 28 points.

If athletes did not participate in their nominated event but participated in another event, they received half points for one event only based on the same scoring criteria as above, e.g. If the 3rd place getter normally received 28 points, they would receive 14 points.

Calculating Total Points.

To allow those who miss the occasional run at West Met the best 10 events of the season are used to calculate the points. Meaning that an athlete ran all 15 West Met's, 5 of the lowest scoring races would be omitted from the final total.

Girraween Athletics Club Publicity Report 2016-2017

This year's publicity report covers the period April 2016 through to March 2017. I have endeavoured over the last twelve months to keep a record of our athlete's achievements within this timeframe. This report is essentially a summation of their achievements within this period.

The 2016 West Metropolitan cross-country season was a successful one for Girraween's athletes. The number of participants was down from 2015. Approximately on average, thirty-one Girraween athletes competed each Saturday afternoon with a highest number of forty-seven competing at Concord early in the season. Once the West Metropolitan awards were handed out in September, seventeen athletes from Girraween won awards across various age categories, in the short, medium and long distance runs. This was only three less than in 2015. The majority, eleven were gained in the short event. This was a very good achievement as many of the categories were very even.

A number of Girraween athletes also competed in the Sydney Marathon Clinic series of races held at Greystanes over the 2015/2016 season which concluded in May 2016. Held from September through to May, this Sydney running institution continues to attract a healthy number of runners who compete over the 5km, 10km and 21/30km distances. The Girraween athletes who compete regularly at Greystanes are always keen for more of their club mates to join them. This season, Carol Adams, Suresh Raju, Rod Zammit, Ed Bratovic, Michael Christie, Geoff Sheargold, Graham Sheargold, Andrew Free, Mischelle Otte, David Otte, Michael Kammerer, Steve Mifsud, Terry Rose and Michael Grogan were all spotted out at Greystanes at various stages of the SMC season and by all accounts were pleased with their performances. We do not have any 2015/2016 season results for our athletes on this occasion, due to various administrative issues that the organisers of SMC had at the back end of the 2015/2016 season. This was a disappointment for all concerned. Thankfully for all participants, these issues have been addressed going forward.

The winter of 2016 also saw a good number of our athletes at Athletics NSW events. Girraween athletes were spotted at such meets as the NSW Cross Country Novice at Ramsgate, NSW State Road Championships at Homebush, NSW Cross-Country relays at Miranda, NSW Cross Country at Nowra, NSW Road Relays at Ourimbah and the NSW Short Course Cross Country at West Dapto. While in 2016, there were no team medals, there were some great individual performances from Brad Milosevic who picked up a silver medal at the NSW Cross Country meet at Nowra and ran consistently elsewhere throughout 2016. It was encouraging to see the number of Girraween athletes competing at these events, particularly in the relays where once again the Girraween philosophy of giving everyone a run who wanted to run was to the fore.

Winter 2016 also saw many Girraween athletes and friends compete in many fun runs and other events outside the scope of West Metropolitan and ANSW sanctioned events. Events such as The Australian Three Days Orienteering Carnival ACT, Two Oceans Ultra Marathon Cape Town South Africa, Australian Athletics Championships, parkrun (various locations), Sydney Striders, Triathlon Pink, Australian Running Festival Canberra, SMC, Hapsa Marathon Hamburg Germany, SMH Half Marathon, Noosa Ultimate Sports Festival, NQSF Student Games/ANQ All Comers Meet Townsville, NSW Throwers Club Permit meet, Gold Coast Winter Series, Monaco Mid-Winter Marathon Nelson New Zealand, Sri Chinmov (various) Gold Coast Marathon and Half Marathon, Sydney Harbour 10km, Georges River Festival of the Feet, Sutherland to Surf, Blacktown Running Festival, Sun Herald City to Surf, Australian Cross-Country Championships and Greater Sydney Half Marathon Unity Walk and Run. This is an exhausting list demonstrating yet again the remarkable versatility of our members and friends all year around. With the onset of the warmer weather, Girraween's Saturday afternoon track and field season ran from September 2016 through to March 2017 at CV Kelly Park Girraween. While the surface when dry was in good condition, there was a deal of rain in the New Year which led to a number of meets having to be cancelled. There are major drainage issues that have yet to be addressed and this will take a lot of time to resolve. On occasion the extreme heat in January and February also impacted on the weekly programme and meetings were cancelled as the welfare of our athletes always comes first. The meets that were held across the season were as a rule well supported. There were also a number of visitors from other clubs

across the summer and they received a warm Girraween welcome. This competition continues to be an important ground for Girraween's athletes at all levels wanting to improve their skills and try out new events in a friendly and competitive environment. It is to be hoped that more athletes are able to take advantage of this competition in coming seasons.

In November 2016, the annual NSW Track and Field Relays were held at Blacktown International Sports Park at Rooty Hill. Girraween entered eight teams across the weekend, and on this occasion one of our teams won a medal. The Men's 4 x 160 100m team of Stephen O'Donnell, Rob Giesler, Claudio Corvalan and Steve Clark won a well-deserved Bronze and were very pleased with their effort. The other Girraween teams were in most cases very competitive and also in some instances not far off a medal. All our members enjoyed the opportunity to compete at such a great facility and in this type of competition. The summer of 2016/2017 also saw Girraween athletes compete at a number of ANSW Inter-Club and Permit meets. Our junior and senior athletes did a fine job representing their club at a number of venues in conditions that were often very challenging. Rob Giesler, Dylan Nagle, Teagan Neich, Brendon Neich, Abbie Stone, Nathan Moffitt, Tyson Smith, Raminder Singh, Claudio Corvalan, Cristobel Corvalan, Tayla Jobson, Nicholas Hanna, Taylor Doyle, Lynette Smith and Michael Grogan all did a superb job representing Girraween across the summer months.

Throughout the 2016/2017 summer season Girraween athletes and friends competed in a large number of other events such as The Australian Mountain Running Association Bush Capital Marathon ACT, parkrun(various), Kinloch Off Road Marathon New Zealand, SIDS Stampede, Rio Paralympic Games, Blackmores Sydney Running Festival, SMC, Sydney Striders, Western Sydney Marathon, Southland Marathon New Zealand, Coleman and Greig Challenge, World Masters Athletics Championships, ASICS Noosa Bolt, Triathlon Pink, Carcoar Running Festival, Golden State Half Marathon USA, Belle Balmain Property Fun Run, Sunday Age City to Sea Melbourne, Mingara One Fitness Central Coast Half Marathon, Australian All Schools Athletics Championships, Throwers Club of NSW Permit Meet, Knapsack Lap Race, Australian Cross Country Selection Trials, NSW Junior Championships, Sun Run, Sydney Striders, B & E Hobart Bridge Run, Sav 10km Malta, Orange Running Festival, Sri Chinmoy, Rush Athletics Hal Safi 5km Malta, NSW Masters, Malta Half Marathon, Six Foot Track, Nagoya City Half Marathon and Australian Athletics Championships. As you can see our athletes do not stop for summer, they keep on going.

Over the previous twelve months there have been many highlights from our athletes who have represented Girraween. All our athletes gave their best when representing Girraween and this is what counts. There were a number of standout performances. Taylor Doyle won the silver medal in the Women's Long Jump T38 classification at the Rio Paralympic Games. This was an extraordinary performance by Taylor and in the long history of Girraween Athletics Club ranks as one of the, if not the greatest performance by a Girraween athlete to-date.

Taylor overcame incredible adversity to be selected for Australia for the Rio Paralympics in 2016. In the months leading up to the Rio Paralympics, Taylor had to overcome various injuries and illnesses to make the Australian qualifying standard, travelling and competing in many meets to obtain the standard. To even be selected for the Australian team given what Taylor overcame, was in it-self remarkable, but to go on and win a silver medal against a very strong field was a wonderful achievement which will never be forgotten by those members and friends who were privileged to watch the coverage of Taylor's event. Brad Milosevic had another consistent twelve months continuing to compete very well at the highest level. His major achievements in this time included a 2nd in the NSW Cross-Country Championships at Nowra, 1st in the Bridge Run in the Sydney Running Festival, 2nd in the Half Marathon in the prestigious Melbourne Running Festival and 1st in the Nagoya City Half Marathon in Japan, the second time in three years that he has won this prestigious international event. Brad continues to be a wonderful representative for his sport and for Girraween Athletics Club. Brendon Neich continues his development as one of Australia's up and coming young Hammer Thrower's and had another solid twelve months. In his age group he was 1st in the NSW Club and Combined Championships, 1st in the NSW Junior Championships and 1st at the NSW All Comers meet. He was also performed very well on the national stage, finishing in the top ten at the Australian All Schools Championships and top five in the Australian Junior Championships in events that had very deep fields. His consistency continues to be remarkable against top competition.

In conclusion, it's been another remarkable twelve months, a period in the Girraween Athletics story that won't be forgotten. Our athletes continue to amaze us all with their versatility across a wide range of events and their willingness to give events a go well outside their comfort zone. Long may this continue.
