You can't go past the performances of Girraween's athletes at the NSW Short Course Cross-Country Championships held at Upjohn Park Dundas early in the month. Girraween came away with a total of six medals at these championships - the greatest single day at a NSW Winter Championships in the club's forty year history. Brad Milosevic incredibly came away with three, winning the Open Men's Championships, picking up another gold in the 30-34 category as well as being part of the Men's 30-39 team along with Geoff Sheargold, Shane Clubb and Tipene Robinson who picked up a well-deserved bronze. It was a tremendous run by Brad in the Open Championship race and he built up his lead gradually with a well-paced race. Lisa Grant picked up a gold medal in the 30-34 Women's category, Tony Coles silver in the 55-59 Men's category, and Graham Sheargold, Andrew Free, Stephen Mifsud and Rob Eager in the 60-69 Men's team event picked up a well-earned silver medal. Congratulations to all these runners who did a remarkable job. It would also be remiss of me not to mention our other athletes who represented Girraween on the day and did a fine job. Thank you to Andrew Free for organising our teams and ensuring that ANSW did reward our athletes where appropriate. Girraween also operated the canteen and provided marshals on the day and thank you to all our volunteers who helped out in setting up and packing away the canteen, working on the canteen throughout the day and marshalling out on the course throughout the day. You all did an amazing job. George and Judy Milosevic were instrumental in assisting with the BBQ and it is due to their fine work that GAC continues the high standard of culinary delights emanating from this production. It certainly was a day to remember.

The Sun-Herald City to Surf was once again held in August and there was a great representation from Girraween members and friends with a number of excellent efforts. Geoff Sheargold was the first Girraween athlete across the line with a time in the low fifty minute region, a very fine performance. Lisa Grant and Steve Clark were other athletes who caught the eye with times just over the hour, another very fine effort by both athletes. Lynette Gillies also completed the course with a very fine performance. Given Lynette's major health issues only a few months before, it was indeed remarkable and her run was incredibly inspirational to us all and we were all very excited for her. Lynette Gillies, you are a star!

The indomitable Brad Milosevic also competed in the Australian Cross-Country Championships at Kembla Grange in August and in a very high standard field, finished well inside the top ten with another excellent effort. He continues to run to a very high standard and we all wish Brad well as he continues his athletic journey.

What can one say about parkrun? A rhetorical question to be sure, but nevertheless it continues to develop and Girraween athletes' performances throughout August were indeed remarkable. Adam Etherington gained three new pb's, Wayne Thurlow two and Steve Clark, Amelia Clark, Carly Eager, Shane Clubb and Lynette Gillies one each. It's never easy to gain a new pb, but the fact that there were a number of athletes to do this was eyecatching to say the least. Adam Etherington's three new pb's was one of the more remarkable efforts at parkrun in recent times given that his times were in the region of the twenty to twenty-one minute range on challenging courses. Well done Adam. At the end of the month a number of Girraween athletes took on pacers duties at Rooty Hill parkrun and they all did a remarkable job. It's always a tricky task and due to their fine work, there were a number of new pb's by athletes on the day. Congratulations to all concerned.

The Run NSW Greater Bank Sydney Half Marathon was held around Sydney Olympic Park towards the end of the month and there were a number of fine efforts by Girraween representatives. Both Tony Coles and Nicholas Hanna ran under ninety minutes and Rod Zammit was not far over the ninety minute mark - all running excellently. It was also nice to see both Wayne Thurlow and Michael Grogan rolling back the years in tackling the Half and both runners should be pleased with their efforts. Both Kim Coles and Terry Rose also had a run in the 7km fun run and enjoyed the experience, running well.

The Mudgee Running festival saw a small Girraween contingent make the trip west in August to enjoy country hospitality and have a run into the bargain. Tony Coles, Graham Sheargold and Suresh Raju all had a run in the Half-Marathon and did well, with Tony coming first in the 50-59 category with an excellent run. Tony is having an amazing winter season in 2019 and his running is continuing to go from strength to strength. Both Kim Coles and Terry Rose had fine runs in the 10km Fun Run at Mudgee with Terry finishing third in the 60-69 category, with another consistent effort.

There is no doubt that August 2019 was a month to remember for Girraween Athletics Club, given the level of performance by so many of Girraween's athletes. It was exciting to see so many of Girraween athletes perform so well across a range of events.
